²⁶The LORD lift up His face to you,
And give you peace (*shalom*).⁷

Peace (Shalom/Eirene)

Shalom means completeness, wholeness, health, peace, welfare, safety, soundness, tranquility, prosperity, perfectness, fullness, rest, harmony, the absence of agitation or discord and a sense of no indebtedness.

Haggai 2:1-9 NASB

2 On the twenty-first of the seventh month, the word of the LORD came by Haggai the prophet, saying, ²“Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, saying, ³“Who is left among you who saw this temple in its former glory? And how do you see it now? Does it not seem to you like nothing in comparison? ⁴But now take courage, Zerubbabel,’ declares the LORD, ‘take courage also, Joshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and all you people of the land take courage,’ declares the LORD, ‘and work; for I am with you,’ declares the LORD of armies. ⁵‘As for the promise which I made you when you came out of Egypt, My Spirit remains in your midst; do not fear!’ ⁶For this is what the LORD of armies says: ‘Once more in a little while, I am going to shake the heavens and the earth, the sea also and the dry land. ⁷I will shake all the nations; and they will come *with* the wealth of all nations, and I will fill this house with glory,’ says the LORD of armies. ⁸‘The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine,’ declares the LORD of armies. ⁹‘The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former,’ says the LORD of armies, ‘and in this place I will give peace (*shalom*),’ declares the LORD of armies.”

Numbers 6:22-27 NASB

²²Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²³“Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, ‘In this way you shall bless the sons of Israel. You are to say to them:

²⁴The LORD bless you, and keep you;

²⁵The LORD cause His face to shine on you,
And be gracious to you;

²⁶The LORD lift up His face to you,
And give you peace (*shalom*).’

²⁷So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and *then* I will bless them.”

¹⁶ I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, so that He may be with you forever; ¹⁷ *the Helper is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him; but you know Him because He remains with you and will be in you.*

¹⁸ “I will not leave you as orphans; I am coming to you. ¹⁹ After a little while, the world no longer *is going to see Me*, but you *are going to see Me*; because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ On that day you will know that I *am* in My Father, and you *are* in Me, and I in you. ²¹ The one who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who loves Me; and the one who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will reveal Myself to him.”

²² Judas (not Iscariot) * said to Him, “Lord, what has happened that You are going to reveal Yourself to us and not to the world?”

²³ Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will follow My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make *Our* dwelling with him. ²⁴ The one who does not love Me does not follow My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father’s who sent Me.

²⁵ “These things I have spoken to you while remaining with you.

²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and remind you of all that I said to you. ²⁷ Peace (*Eirene/shalom*) I leave you, My peace I give you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor fearful. ²⁸ You heard that I said to you, ‘I am going away, and I am coming to you.’ If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. ²⁹ And now I have told you before it happens, so that when it happens, you may believe. ³⁰ I will not speak much more with you, for the ruler of the world is coming, and he has nothing in *regard to Me*, ³¹ but so that the world may know that I

love the Father, I do exactly as the Father commanded Me. Get up, let's go from here.

Romans 8:1-11 NASB

8 Therefore there is now no condemnation at all for those who are in Christ Jesus. ²For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. ³For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God *did*: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and *as an offering* for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. ⁵For those who are in accord with the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are in accord with the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. ⁶For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace (*Eirene/shalom*), ⁷because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*, ⁸and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

⁹However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him. ¹⁰If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness. ¹¹But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Ephesians 2:1-22 NASB

2 And you were dead in your offenses and sins, ²in which you previously walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. ³Among them we too all previously lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the rest. ⁴But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵even when we were dead in our wrongdoings, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus, ⁷so that in the ages to come He might show the boundless riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith; and this *is* not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; ⁹not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

¹¹Therefore remember that previously you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called “Uncircumcision” by the so-called “Circumcision” *which is* performed in the flesh by human hands—¹²*remember* that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the people of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of the promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

¹³But now in Christ Jesus you who previously were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. ¹⁴For He Himself is our peace(*eirene/shalom*), who made both *groups into* one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, ¹⁵by abolishing in His flesh the hostility, *which is* the Law *composed* of commandments *expressed* in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two one new person, *in this way* establishing peace; ¹⁶and that He might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross,

by it having put to death the hostility. ¹⁷ And He came and preached peace (*eirene/shalom*) to you who were far away, and peace (*eirene/shalom*) to those who were near; ¹⁸ for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, ²⁰ having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, ²² in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.
